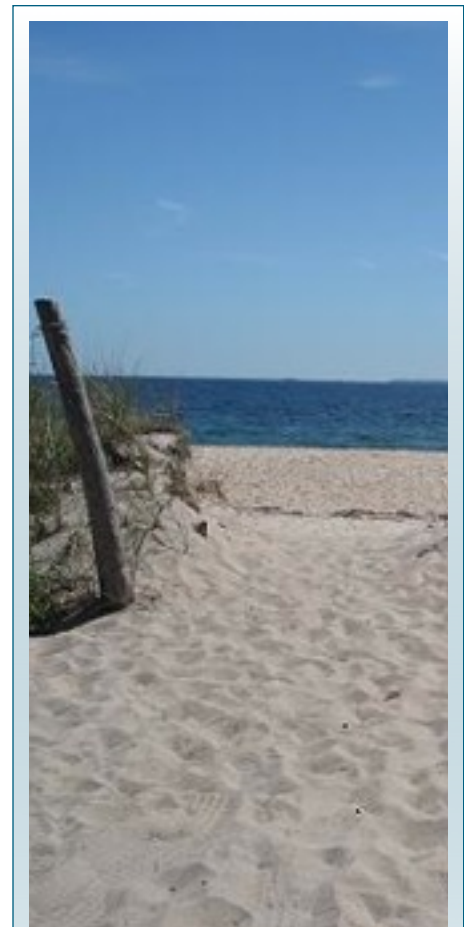
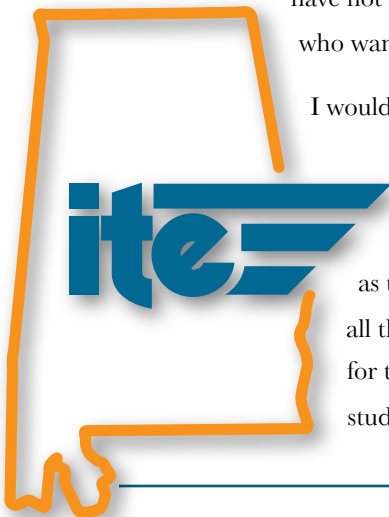
### PRESIDENT’S MESSAGE

## LEADERSHIP TRAINING

ALSITE is sponsoring two sessions of Leadership Training on June 25/26 and August 27/28 at Shocco Springs Baptist Conference Center in Talladega. The program was originally developed by the Southern District ITE (SDITE) in response to a request by the Georgia Section ITE in 2008. The pilot session of the Leadership Development was given to the Georgia Section in 2009. During the second session, the Alabama Section was allowed to send an observer who brought back a glowing report for the material and instructors. The ALSITE Board elected to bring the training to Alabama in 2010, and received a \$2000 grant from SDITE to help defray expenses.

Key individuals with SDITE who assembled the leadership training materials

include Richard Atkins (SC), John Edwards (GA), Bill Seymour (KY), Brent McKinney (NC), and our very own Dan Turner. Local instructors Darrell Skipper and Becky White will also be facilitating in the June session. There are 14 different modules which are covered in the training sessions. Examples of these modules include Conducting Effective Meetings, Effective Leader Communications, Developing Effective Relationships with Elected Officials, Mentoring Employees, and Developing Vision and Action Plans.

The leadership training is meant to be very personal and interactive, and therefore the participant list is very small. Thus far, 11 ALSITE members have registered to attend. In addition, ALSITE extended an invitation to the Deep South Section ITE

to participate in the training session, and they will be sending two people as well. It is the intention of ALSITE to offer the complete leadership training class again in the future if there is interest in the State.

At the SDITE meeting in Portsmouth, three ALSITE members participated in an overview of the leadership training (Becky White, Scott Holladay, and Richard Caudle). These three ALSITE members will be conducting the Professional Development Session at the Annual Meeting in Gulf Shores on Wednesday, June 9 to give the ALSITE membership at large a taste of the leadership training materials.

## ITE Meetings
